Pastor Chick Lane serves as Pastor for Stewardship and Generosity at Lord of Life Lutheran Church in Maple Grove, Minnesota. Previously he worked as a consultant with Kairos and Associates, and served as Director of the Center for Stewardship Leaders at Luther Seminary, Director for Stewardship Key Leader in the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, Assistant to the Bishop in the Northwestern Minnesota Synod of the ELCA, and pastor of three congregations, one in Pennsylvania and two in Minnesota.

Grace Duddy Pomroy is a millennial stewardship ministry leader. She graduated from Luther Seminary in 2012 with a Master’s of Arts degree in Congregational Mission and Leadership. She served as the Assistant Director of the Center for Stewardship Leaders at Luther Seminary and the Executive Director of Operations for Kairos and Associates and the Joshua Group. She is currently the Financial Education Specialist at Portico Benefit Services.
