READING THE O.T. THROUGH JEWISH EYES by Rabbi Evan Moffic






RE:FORM: ANCESTORS NEW TESTAMENT from Sparkhouse

THE WOMAN'S LECTIONARY: PREACHING THE WOMEN OF THE BIBLE THROUGHOUT THE YEAR



CONNECTIONS: YEAR B, VOLUME 3: SEASON AFTER PENTECOST



WORSHIP FOR THE WHOLE PEOPLE OF GOD: SECOND EDITION by Ruth Duck



IF GOD IS LOVE DON'T'E BE A JERK by John Pavlovitz




NATIVE AMERICAN RESILIENCE: A STORY OF RACISM, GENOCIDE AND SURVIVAL by P.S. Steng


MADNESS AND GRACE by Matthew S. Stanford, PhD.


FAITH AFTER DOUBT by Brian D. McLaren

PSOBRIETY: A JOURNEY OF RECOVERY THROUGH THE PSALMS by Jeff Dafler




LIBERTY'S CIVIL RIGHTS ROAD TRIP by Michael W. Waters


GOD'S COMING TO VISIT by Franz Hubner

THREE LINES IN A CIRCLE by Michael G. Long


